TTA's Position on Faculty Meetings

Faculty meetings are set in both frequency and duration per the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) (Article VI;L). Faculty meetings should be held when there is important information to share with **everyone** that requires feedback and collaboration regarding site logistics. Agendas for faculty meetings should be developed collaboratively and effectively communicated by Noon at least **2 work days** in advance. The meetings should be a place to voice concerns, solicit feedback, and develop solutions through professional collaboration. TTA believes the operational aspects of this definition will improve morale and foster a cohesive work environment through active participation in solving site issues that need to be addressed.

TTA believes that items which could be communicated via memo/email should be excluded from Faculty Meeting agendas. Items like this should initiate a conversation with the site administrator as to why this meeting needed to be held in person.
