

PROP 55 EXTENSION



Before you submit any petitions, complete the following quality control steps for every petition collected. Invalid signatures **DO NOT COUNT** toward our goal. Duplicate signatures count **AGAINST** our goal.

STEPS FOR QUALITY CONTROL: >>>>



STEP 1. INK

- Signatures must be collected using **BLACK or BLUE** ballpoint pens. Signatures in pencil, marker or felt tip pens are invalid and must be crossed out and not counted.



STEP 2. COUNTY

- Make sure all signatures on the petition are voters that live in the county written at the top. For example: if you are circulating a Los Angeles County Petition, someone that is registered in San Francisco cannot sign that sheet. Signature Gatherers should start a fresh sheet for every county, even if there is only 1 signature collected on that sheet.



STEP 3. SIGNATURES

- Is the writing legible?
- Is the name printed on the top line?
- Is there a signature on the signature line underneath the printed name?
- Is there an address that includes the word Street, Drive, Blvd, Avenue, etc...? No P.O. Boxes!
- Is there a city and a zip code?



STEP 4. DECLARATION OF CIRCULATOR

- Did the signature-gatherer write their name?
- Did they write their home address without abbreviations including city, state, zip code? **No P.O. Boxes!**
- Did they write the date range that they collected all signatures on that page?
- Is the date on "Executed on" **after or on (not before)** the date range listed above?
- Did they write the city where they collected the signatures in the "AT" field?
- Did they sign their name?
